For paper presentations:

- The abstract should be submitted in the APA format in a Word document (Times New Roman font, size 12 with double line spacing with a maximum of 300 words and 5 keywords) with proper name and details.
- If abstract is selected, the full paper not exceeding 2000 words in soft copy should be submitted.
- Maximum three registered authors per paper (including a guide).
- Affiliation of the authors and the E-mail ID of the primary author should be included in the abstract.
- If the presenter is from outside Kuvempu university jurisdiction. (Other than Shivamogga or Chikkamagaluru Districts) presenter can choose online mode also with prior arrangement.
- The presentation time limit is 8 + 2 minutes per paper.
- Selected papers will be published in an ISBN peer reviewed book with nominal fee which will be informed later.

For poster presentations:

- Posters could be presented in either Kannada or English
- Posters should be printed in Flex material (3x4 feet (36 inch x 48 inch))
- Specific time and place shall be allotted for poster presentation
- Authors should be present during the time for explanation (maximum 5 minutes)
- Last date for submission of abstracts for poster is 25, March 2026
